Please help us stay safe and continue working during the pandemic. We have reviewed the way we work to keep the public and staff safe. If you are near where we are working, please follow the guidelines set by the government.



Dear Businesses and Residents,

We are writing to you to let you know that road works will be taking place in Penny Street.

When are the works taking place?

The works will start on Tuesday 11 August and will take up to 5 working days to complete, weather permitting. Our working hours will be 7:30am—5:00pm. There will be no weekend working. The road will be closed to traffic from Thursday 13 August to Monday 17 August. Diversions will be in place and there will be no on-street parking whilst the road is closed.

Tuesday 11 August-Thursday 13 August*	Preparatory works on whole road
Thursday 13 August-Friday 14 August**	Excavation of the current surface and Laying of new surface
Friday 14 August-Monday 17 August**	Laying of road markings

*No Road closures—no overall parking restriction

** Road closed to traffic—no on-street parking during working hours 7:30am—5:00pm

What precautions should I take during the road works?

Do not walk or cycle on the newly laid, hot surface. If you walk or cycle on the road by mistake, please check that you don't have bitumen on your shoes or bike. In the event that you do get bitumen on your clothes or shoes, it can be removed with a proprietary cleaner. Please also look out for your pets walking on the new surface especially cats who may be out roaming around.



Frequently asked questions

Q. Why are you doing this?

A. We are contracted to maintain the roads and pavements in the city. Penny Street has been highlighted as requiring resurfacing works to increase the longevity of the road.

Q. What impact could the roadworks have on me?

A. There will be no on-street parking in Penny Street during excavation, surfacing and road markings. Please be advised that any vehicle hindering or obstructing our operations will need to be moved under The Portsmouth City Council (Tertiary Road Network - Various Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.59) Order 2020. Please park your vehicle in an alternative location such as on neighbouring streets to help us complete the work quickly.

Road users are advised to expect some delays and use alternative routes where possible. Please also allow extra time for journeys. We will endeavour to maintain vehicular access for residents and businesses, however, this will be restricted at times. Footways will be open for pedestrians.

Q. Will the work be noisy?

A. Some aspects of this work will be noisy, mostly the excavation of the road surface which starts on Thursday 13 August. There will also be beepers from our vehicles when reversing, these are mandatory for health and safety reasons. We will endeavour to keep all noise to a minimum and your patience on this matter is appreciated.
