**Re: Great South Run 2024 parking restrictions and road closures**

We're writing to inform you of roads that will be closed and restrictions to parking over the weekend of Friday 18 to Sunday 20 October 2024 for this year's Great South Run.

Parking restrictions will be in place from 6am Monday 14 October on Clarence Esplanade (between Avenue de Caen to Jack Cockerill Way), and Jack Cockerill Way. Also, from 8am Friday 18 October on Clarence Esplanade (between South Parade to Jack Cockerill Way), and Victoria Avenue Spur. These will remain in place until the event finishes at about 5pm on Sunday 20 October.

For the Great South Run 5K, road closures will be in place from 10am on Saturday 19 October. on Clarence Esplanade from South Parade to Clarence Pier, Long Curtain Road, Pier Road (south of Duisburg Way), Pembroke Road (Southside Footway) and Avenue de Caen. Western Parade will be closed from 9am to 1pm so that vehicles can be removed.

Parking restrictions will be enforced from 5am on Sunday 20 October in:

- Pier Road (north from its junction with Duisburg Way to Southsea Terrace)
- Duisburg Way
- Victoria Avenue
- Pembroke Road
- High Street (Old Portsmouth) - 6 spaces on southbound carriageway outside The George Court.
- Clarence Parade (north side) - All bays between Queens Hotel entrance and Auckland Road West, as well as 3 spaces outside 2-3 Lennox Mansions.
- Clarence Parade (south side) - 1 bay west and 16 spaces east of Serpentine Road. 4 spaces opposite 7-9 Clarence Parade.
- South Parade - all bays from the junction of Eastern Villas Road and The Dell to Clarendon Road.

Between 9am Sunday 20 October to 1.15pm, there will no access out of Old Portsmouth (except for Emergency Services) from Gunwharf Road, roads West of Pier Road or South of St George's Road and Museum Road. Ten parking spaces on Western Parade will be suspended opposite numbers 1 - 4 from 8am Saturday 19 October until 5pm Sunday 20 October. From 9am on Saturday 19 October, any vehicles parked in suspended areas will be removed to Victoria Avenue. Any vehicle parked in a suspended area or obstructing the highway may receive a Penalty Charge Notice in addition to being removed.

Traffic diversion signs will be in place at all locations affected by road closures. Competitors should be passing the Old Portsmouth and Southsea seafront area between 10am and 1pm approximately.
